1. Parents must attend all functions with the teens unless another parent has agreed to stand in for them.
2. Clean up after ZOE meetings as needed according to the clean-up checklist.
3. Each family needs to take on at least **one** of the jobs listed. Additionally, if you have a graduating Senior you will need to take yet another responsibility to work on the Graduation Committee throughout the year. This is a special time for each Senior and it takes a lot of time and planning to guarantee a memorable graduating event.
