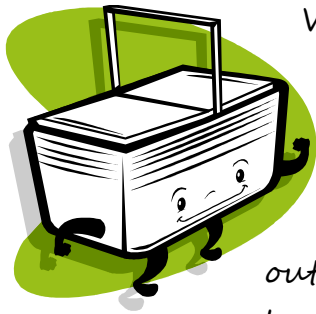

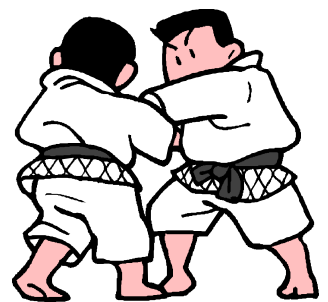
UNARMED STAGE COMBAT CLASS

WHEN: Saturday, May 7 - June 11, 8:30-9:30 AM

COST: \$75 (*Active Cast Members) / \$90 (Non-cast) Must be at least 13 years old to participate.

Besides being great exercise, these classes are designed to



equip individuals with the stage combat skills they need to execute safe and believable unarmed fight choreography on stage.

Kelly Grenga is an Actor/Combatant with the Society of American Fight Directors (SAFD), a 4th degree black belt Mixed Martial Arts Instructor, and Fight Director at NarrowWay.

Topics to be covered:

- Stage combat safety
- Stage Slaps, punches, kicks, hair pulls, knees, elbows, pushes, clashes, throws and other wonderful things
- How to safely execute stage falls and rolls
- Believable knaps and other stage sound effects
- Angles, reactions, and how to make your fight believable to the audience

Class size is limited to 14 people, on a first-come first-served basis. Minimum age is 13 years old and all participants under the age of 18 will need parental consent forms signed prior to or at the first class. Classes are \$75.00 for *NarrowWay cast members who have been active in two or more NarrowWay shows within the past 12 months and \$90.00 for non-cast members. Latin, French and Spanish for high school

Needing a foreign language for your high schooler? Latin 1, French 1 and 2, and Spanish 1 and 2 are being offered for the 2011-2012 school year through Shanan Classical Tutorials (Weddington, but serving the greater South Charlotte, Union Co. and Fort Mill communities). These are 2-semester classes that count as one foreign language credit.

The goal for all languages is to be able to utilize the language in speaking, but also know the grammar. Thus several methods are employed with some out-of-the-classroom experiences. It is advisable to take Latin first as a foundational language before the Romance languages (French and Spanish), but is not

necessary. Latin course goals include laying a foundation for vocabulary which in turn helps with SAT/ACT tests.

The tutors, Mrs. Gloria Yanes for Spanish and Ms. Amandine Farrugia for French, are not only qualified and enthusiastic instructors who bring their passion for working with students to the classes, but they are also native-speaking individuals. Mrs. Katy Wienecke, is a very passionate enthusiastic instructor for Latin who wants to bring the "dead" language to life and show very practical applications.

For more information regarding the tutors, the courses, texts, and other courses offered, visit the website, www.shananclassical.com. The fee for the languages is \$120 for the fall and \$136 for the spring. They meet once per week on Mondays for one and a quarter hours.

Doors open 6:30pm - Concert begins at 7:30pm

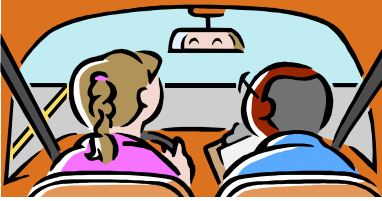
